ON-LINE EXAMINATION - FOR RECRUITMENT OF CLERKS

INFORMATION HANDOUT

This handout contains details pertaining to various aspects of the online exam you are going to undertake on 28th April 2018 at a center which will be notified to you. It also contains important instructions about examination and related matters. You are advised to study the handout carefully as it will help you in preparing for the examination.

The online examination will comprise the following objective type multiple choice tests as stated below:

The time for the test is 120 minutes; however, you may have to be at the venue for approximately 180 minutes including the time required for logging in, collection of the call letters, giving of instructions etc. The tests will be provided in English only. You can attempt any question from 1 to 200 at any point of time within these 120 minutes. All the questions will have multiple choices. Out of the four answers to a question only one will be the correct answer. You have to select the answer and 'mouse click' that alternative which you feel is appropriate/correct. The alternative/option that you have clicked on will be highlighted and will be treated as your answer to that question. There will be penalty for wrong answers marked by you. For every wrong answer marked by you, 0.25 of the marks assigned to that question will be deducted as penalty.

Please note that questions below in this handout are only illustrative and meant to give you an understanding of the type of questions in the examination. Some sample questions are given below.

Reasoning

This is a test to see how well you can think. It contains questions of various kinds

Directions: In each of the following questions, there are four groups of letters or words in each question. Three of these letter groups or words are alike in some way, while one is different. Find the one which is different.

Q.3. (1) Mango (2) Apple (3) Orange (4) Rose

Directions: In each of the following questions, there is a question mark in which only one of the four alternatives given under the question satisfies the same relationship as is found between the two terms to the left of the sign :: given in the question. Find the correct answer.

Q.4. Foot : man :: hoof : ?

Q.5. If the letters in the word TOPS can be rearranged to form a meaningful word beginning with O, the last letter of that word is your answer. If more than one such word can be formed, M is the answer and if no such word can be formed, X is the answer.

This is a test to see how well you know English. Your English language ability would be tested through questions on grammar, vocabulary, sentence completion, synonyms, antonyms, comprehension of a passage, etc. Study and answer the sample questions given below:



Login Page

- **Username**

- **Password**

- **Test selection**

Users are required to select their test from the dropdown.

- **Sign In**


After entering Username, Password and selecting test click on “Sign In” button. If provided details are correct, user logs in and is redirected to examination page.

- **Login Failed**-Login failed message is displayed if,

1. User has entered incorrect username, password or test combination.
2. User has submitted test through “Submit Test” button.
3. User has exceeded allotted examination time.
4. User has exceeded maximum number of re-logins.

Time remaining is displayed at top-right of the page.

- **Question Information**


Question number, marks for question, bookmark and Invalid status of question is displayed in this section which appears below the top row.

- **Question Description**

This section (light gray box) is the actual question displayed to user.

- **Options**

- **Navigation**

Bottom-center of exam page has four navigation links (First, Previous, Next, Last) to move across questions.

- **Questions,Bookmark and Invalid**

Clicking on “Questions” buttons shows list of questions
Clicking on “Bookmark” button adds a bookmark icon to the question in case user wants to revisit the question later.
Clicking on “Invalid” button adds a Invalid icon to the question in case user believes that the correct answer does not exists in the options

- **Clear and Submit Test**

Bottom-right of the page has two buttons. Clicking on “Clear” deselects option if user has selected one. Clicking on “Submit Test” button prompts user to confirm that user wants to submit/end test.
